

With the increase in Covid numbers we want to let you know that we are following the requirements and guidelines of our Diocese, the New York State Department of Health, and the Center for Disease Control for cleaning, hygiene, and social distancing.

Christ Church plans to implement stronger protocols, but we will remain open at this time. We will evaluate weekly so please check website for updates.

For the safety of people who choose to attend a service in person, a number of changes are required.

- You **MUST** wear your mask and **KEEP IT UP OVER YOUR NOSE** at all times.
- Temperatures will be taken when you enter the building and you will need to sign in for tracing purposes.
- Everyone is requested to use hand sanitizer when entering the welcome center.
- 6-foot distancing is to be practiced at all times.
- Please do not come if you have these symptoms:
 - a) not feeling well
 - b) running a fever (100.4 or higher)
 - c) dry coughing

Please do not come if you have been in contact with someone known to have the coronavirus (even if not showing symptoms), until they are well, or have completed self-quarantine.

Two pews will be blocked off between seating for further distancing. A reminder when service is over that you not visit but leave keeping a 6-foot distance between yourself and others.
