#### **DEACON'S CORNER**

Hello! I am Deacon Lynne Crimi. Father Roy asked me to tell you a little about myself. I have been a member of Christ Church for 22 years and was ordained a deacon in 2005. My husband Dennis and I have been married for 56 years. We have been blessed with three children and two grandchildren. Sadly, our daughter died in 2004 of a brain injury caused from a skiing accident. Our family knows that she is in a better place, but we still miss her terribly.

I graduated from Russell Sage College, received a Masters Degree in Social Work from Rutgers University, and worked at Morristown Memorial Hospital in the Cancer Center for 10 years. Working at the hospital enabled me to be trained by Dr. Herbert Benson of the Mind/Body Medical Institute. From him, I learned how to teach patients "the relaxation response" and various other coping skills as a means to help them maintain their health and to help treat stress-related illness.

I am a cradle Episcopalian, and as I was teaching people with cancer to meditate, I began to see amazing results. This led me to study and practice the healing effects of contemplative prayer for myself and others. In doing this, I was blessed by developing a deeper relationship with God. In 1999 I left the hospital, moved to Saratoga, and worked as a counselor for the Episcopal Counseling Service.

After years of discernment, and help from Father Roy, I felt that the Lord was calling me to become a deacon, and as a deacon, to use my skills to help others cope with life's difficulties. I am presently a spiritual director and have led many Bible studies and retreats. You may not see me on the altar every Sunday, as I'm spending more time with my husband. That being said, I would gladly reach out to you if you desire spiritual direction or want to join one of my classes. Please contact Jeanne, at the church office, if you desire my assistance.
